22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-5-106 is repealed.

24 ~~It shall be unlawful for the owner, manager, superintendent, or other~~  
25 ~~person in control or management of any factory, mill, workshop, mercantile~~  
26 ~~establishment, laundry, or other establishment where three (3) or more~~  
27 ~~persons are employed, all or part of whom are females, to permit in the place~~  
28 ~~of employment any influence, practices, or conditions calculated to~~
