24	(1) Upon receipt of an application for matching funds to match		
25	federal funds from one (1) of the funding agencies identified in § 15-3-205,		
26	establish a chronological order of match eligibility <u>determine the</u>		
27	eligibility for matching funds based on a finding that the proposed research		
28	is in fields having long term economic or commercial value to the state and		
29	which have been identified in the research and development plan approved by		
30	the Board of Directors of the Arkansas Science and Technology Authority;		
31	(2) Promptly review applications for matching funds in the order		
32	of receipt of the applications for a match for consistency with this		
33	subchapter; and		
34	(3) The Board of Directors of the Arkansas Science and		
35	Technology Authority shall ensure that no commitments for matching funds		
36	shall be made in excess of funds available for any given year and shall may		

review and approve those applications which have: (A) Provided the information on the application for matching funds in accordance with the provisions of this subchapter; (B) Included an official notice of award of a research grant from one (1) of the funding agencies identified in § 15-3-205; and (C) Filed a proposal for federal funding consistent with the types of research authorized by this subchapter.
