23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
26 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training - State Operations for
27 the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees
28 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
29 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or
30 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
31 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
32 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
33 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
34 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
35 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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35 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - DRUG DETECTION TRAINING-FEDERAL. There is
 36 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards

1 and Training, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief
 2 Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating expenses of the Arkansas
 3 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training - Drug Detection for the

 17 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
 19 FORWARD. Any unexpended balances of appropriation and funds authorized for
 20 Capital Outlay in Section 2 of this Act on ~~June 30, 2002~~ June 30, 2004, shall
 21 be carried forward and made available for the same purpose during the fiscal
 22 year ending ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~
 24 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

 26 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORMS.
 28 After seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
 29 Budget Committee and approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the
 30 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training shall be exempt from
 31 Arkansas Code 19-6-109(c) for the purpose of buying uniforms for students.
 32 The amount spent for the purchase of uniforms in any one year shall be
 33 limited to \$40,000.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~
 35 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

1 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
2 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
3 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
4 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
7 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
8 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

10
11 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
12 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
13 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
14 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
15 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
17 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
18 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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20 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
21 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
22 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
23 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
24 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
25 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
26 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
27 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
28 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
29 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
30 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
