20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-15-103(f), concerning notification of  
23 state employees subject to criminal background checks, is amended to read as  
24 follows:

25 (f) A state agency shall inform all employees in designated positions  
26 that ~~include, as part of the job description, direct contact with a child~~  
27 ~~that~~:


28 (1) Continued employment is contingent upon the results of a  
29 criminal history check; and

30 (2) The employee has the right to obtain a copy of:

31 (A) The report from the bureau; and

32 (B) The central registry report from the registries.

34 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 21-15-107, concerning the duty of the  
35 Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police to maintain  
36 a data base for criminal background checks of state employment applicants, is



1 amended to read as follows:

2 (c) The Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State  
3 Police shall maintain a database of the results of criminal history checks on  
4 each applicant for employment with and each employee of a state agency in a  
5 designated position ~~that includes, as part of the job description, direct~~  
6 ~~contact with a child or children.~~
