19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-89-518(a) is amended to read as follows:

22 (a)(1) There is created an Amusement Ride Safety Advisory Board.

23 (2) The board shall be appointed by the Governor. The Director
24 of the Department of Labor or his or her designee shall be ex officio chair.
25 The board shall consist of ~~six (6)~~ five (5) additional members:

26 (A) One (1) member of the board shall be the Director of
27 the Department of Parks and Tourism, or his or her designee;

28 ~~(B) One (1) member of the board shall represent insurance~~
29 ~~companies insuring amusement rides in Arkansas;~~

30 ~~(C)~~(B) One (1) member of the board shall represent owners
31 or operators of amusement rides which are portable in nature;

32 ~~(D)~~(C) One (1) member of the board shall represent owners
33 or operators of permanently placed amusement rides;

34 ~~(E)~~(D) One (1) member of the board shall represent fair
35 managers in Arkansas; and

36 ~~(F)~~(E) One (1) member of the board shall represent the



1 general public.

2 (3) The terms of office of the members, other than the Director
3 of the Department of Labor and the Director of the Department of Parks and
4 Tourism, shall be for four (4) years or until a successor is appointed.

5 (4) No member of the board shall be appointed to serve more than
6 two (2) consecutive full terms.

7 (5) At the time of appointment or reappointment, the Governor
8 shall adjust the length of terms to insure that the terms of board members
9 are staggered so that, insofar as is possible, an equal number of members
10 shall rotate each year.
