20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 13-3-101 is amended to read as follows:
23 13-3-101. Creation - Purpose.

24 (a) For the purpose of keeping and caring for the official archives of
25 this state, collecting materials bearing on the history of Arkansas from the
26 earliest times, copying and editing official records and other historical
27 materials, encouraging historical work and research, and performing work in
28 relation to the foregoing, the Arkansas History Commission is created and
29 established at the seat of government of this state.

30 (b) ~~The offices of the commission and the official archives of the~~
31 ~~state shall be in the One Capitol Mall Building, State Capitol, Little Rock.~~
32 The Arkansas History Commission and State Building Services shall determine
33 the facility needs of the commission.

34 (c) State Building Services may locate and negotiate an appropriate
35 facility for the commission, but the commission shall have final approval of
36 the facility's location.
