9 AN ACT TO ADD SHEET METAL WORKERS TO THE LIST OF
10 WORKERS AND CLASS D LICENSES TO THE TYPES OF
11 LICENSES EXEMPTED FROM LICENSURE FOR WORK ON
12 HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR CONDITIONING, AND
13 REFRIGERATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

17 EXEMPTIONS FROM HVACR LICENSURE

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-33-102(b), concerning Exemptions from
24 licensure for Heating, ventilation, air conditioning, and refrigeration work,
25 is amended to read as follows:

26 (b) This chapter shall not apply to a person who:

27 (1) Performs HVACR work in an existing building or structure
28 owned and occupied by him or her as his or her home;

29 (2) Performs HVACR work in an existing building or structure
30 owned or occupied by him or her on his or her farm;

31 (3) Performs work for public utilities on construction,
32 maintenance, and development work that is incidental to their business;

33 (4) Performs work on motor vehicles;

34 (5) Is an architect or registered engineer who designs HVACR
35 systems for design criteria only;

36 (6) Is an employee of a hospital and performs HVACR work that is



1 incidental to the hospital's operation;

2 (7) Installs or does maintenance work on a gas-fired floor
3 furnace, wall furnace, or unit heater, if the person is licensed pursuant to
4 § 17-38-301 et seq. and the work is performed within the limitations of the
5 person's license; or

6 (8) Is a pipefitter, welder, well driller, sheet metal worker,
7 or plumber working under a Class A, Class B, Class D, or Class E licensee and
8 who is enrolled in or has satisfactorily completed an apprenticeship training
9 program approved by the State of Arkansas in his or her respective trade, and
10 the work is performed within the limitations of the person's license.
