## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE CAPITOL  
11 ZONING DISTRICT COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL  
12 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2005; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 AN ACT FOR THE CAPITOL ZONING DISTRICT  
17 COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
18 2003-2005 BIENNIUM.  
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Capitol  
25 Zoning District Commission for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum  
26 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
30 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
31 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
32 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
33 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
34 or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Capitol Zoning District Commission for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Capitol Zoning District Commission, to be payable from the State General Services Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Capitol Zoning District Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 3 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 10 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 17 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 19 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 20 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 21 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
 22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of  
 23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 24 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
 25 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the  
 26 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
 27 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
 28 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
 29 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
