21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-37-203 is amended to read as follows:  
24 27-37-203. Vehicles transporting explosives.

25 (a) Any person operating any vehicle transporting any explosive as a  
26 cargo or other dangerous articles upon a highway shall, at all times, comply  
27 with the ~~provisions of~~ requirements of the regulations promulgated under this  
28 section.

29 ~~(b) The vehicle shall be marked or placarded on each side and the rear~~  
30 ~~with the word "EXPLOSIVES" in letters not less than eight inches (8") high,~~  
31 ~~or there shall be displayed on the rear of the vehicle a red flag not less~~  
32 ~~than twenty four inches (24") square marked with the word "DANGER" in white~~  
33 ~~letters six inches (6") high.~~

34 ~~(c) Every vehicle shall be equipped with not less than two (2) fire~~  
35 ~~extinguishers filled and ready for immediate use and placed at a convenient~~  
36 ~~point on the vehicle so used.~~
