19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. (a)(1) Any person who held a valid teaching license prior
22 to January 1, 1988, shall be allowed to renew that teaching license by
23 meeting the general renewal requirements that are applicable to renewal for
24 all other license holders and shall not be required to comply with Arkansas
25 Code §§ 6-17-601 through 6-17-603, to take a basic skills test, to take the
26 National Teacher's Exam, or fulfill any other requirement that is not also
27 required of all other teachers for license renewal.

28 (2) Any person that held a valid teaching license prior to
29 January 1, 1988, shall be entitled to a provisional license by meeting the
30 general requirements that are applicable to all other persons seeking a
31 provisional license.

32 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to allow a person whose
33 license was revoked under Arkansas Code §§ 6-17-405 through 6-17-408 to be
34 allowed to renew his or her license.
