13 AN ACT TO ALLOW TRANSFERS FROM THE MOTOR
14 VEHICLE ACQUISITION REVOLVING FUND.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 22-8-206 is amended to read as follows:
21 22-8-206. Purchase of automobiles.

22 (a) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
23 purchase vehicles for state agencies from moneys as appropriated and made
24 available by the General Assembly.

25 (b) There is created and established upon the financial records of the
26 Department of Finance and Administration, the Treasurer of State, and the
27 Auditor of State a fund to be known as the "Motor Vehicle Acquisition
28 Revolving Fund", which shall be used for the purpose of acquiring motor
29 vehicles as authorized by this subchapter.

30 (c)(1) The Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be financed
31 by its proportionate share of moneys made available from:

32 (A) The allocation of general revenues as authorized by
33 the Revenue Stabilization Law, § 19-5-101 et seq.;

34 (B) Moneys made available upon the disposal of used
35 vehicles, which moneys shall be deposited to the credit of the Motor Vehicle



1 Acquisition Revolving Fund rather than being deposited to the owning state
 2 agency's fund;

3 (C) Deposits of moneys from benefiting state agencies; and

4 (D) Transfers from other State Treasury funds and fund
 5 accounts of benefiting state agencies.

6 (2) Upon approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the
 7 appropriation and funds shall be transferred from the Motor Vehicle
 8 Acquisition Revolving Fund to the designated appropriation and fund of the
 9 state agency.

10 (d)(1) In the event that the director determines that any state
 11 agency, as defined by ~~§ 22-8-203(3)~~ § 22-8-203(4), has sufficient funding
 12 from sources other than general revenues which may be used to purchase
 13 vehicles requested by the agency, he or she shall transfer, on his or her
 14 books and on the books of the Auditor of State and the Treasurer of State, an
 15 amount equal to the price of the vehicles from the fund from which the
 16 funding is available to the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund.

17 (2) Upon approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the
 18 Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund appropriation shall be transferred
 19 from the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund to the designated
 20 appropriation of the state agency.

21 (3) In the event that the funds are held in depositories other
 22 than the State Treasury, the administrative head of the affected state agency
 23 shall issue a check drawn against the funds, which shall be deposited in the
 24 Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund as a nonrevenue receipt.

25 ~~(e) All deposits and transfers, other than transfers from the General
 26 Revenue Fund Account of the State Apportionment Fund, made to the Motor
 27 Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be classified as a refund to
 28 expenditure.~~

29 ~~(f)~~(e) After seeking the advice of the Legislative Council, in order
 30 to effectuate the intent and purposes of this subchapter, the Chief Fiscal
 31 Officer of the State shall have the authority to transfer ~~appropriations:~~

32 (1) ~~From~~ Appropriations from the Property Sale Holding
 33 Appropriation to the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund appropriation;
 34 and

35 (2) ~~From the appropriation or budget classification provided by
 36 the General Assembly for the purchase of automobiles or pickup trucks to the~~

1 ~~Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund appropriation~~ Appropriations or
2 funds from the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund to the designated
3 state agency appropriation and fund from which the payment for the purchase
4 of vehicles is to be made.

5 ~~(g)~~(f) The Department of Human Services is hereby exempt from this
6 section insofar that federal funds and state general revenues necessary to
7 match the federal funds may be transferred to the Motor Vehicle Acquisition
8 Revolving Fund when the Director of the Department of Finance and
9 Administration has determined that the Department of Human Services has
10 sufficient funding which may be used to purchase requested vehicles.
