7	(2) To convey any and all of the land and other property
8	acquired to the United States Government, or any of its agencies, to be used
9	as a part of a national park or to convey it to the Department of Parks and
10	Tourism for maintenance and operation as a part of the state parks system if
11	the commission deems it in the best interest of the state;
12	(3) To exercise the right of eminent domain to appropriate or
13	condemn lands or improvements thereon, or waters as may be necessary for
14	inclusion in the Prairie Grove Battlefield project authorized in this
15	subchapter, which condemnation shall be in conformity with the requirements
16	set forth in the laws of this state under which the State Highway Commission
17	is authorized to appropriate and condemn lands and improvements thereon;
18	(4) To employ such legal counsel, engineers, surveyors, or other
19	personnel as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this subchapter;

21	(5) To accept gifts, grants, or donations of real or personal
22	property to be used for the purposes of this subchapter.

24	13-7-404. Acquisition of land.
25	(a) Before the Prairie Grove Battlefield Commission shall buy any land
26	under the provisions of this subchapter, the commission shall cause an
27	appraisal of the land to be made by three (3) qualified and impartial
28	appraisers, and the commission shall not pay any greater price for the land
29	than the appraised value thereof.
30	(b) If the owner or owners of the land refuse to sell it to the
31	commission or if they seek a greater price than the appraised value of the
32	land, the commission may acquire the land by condemnation as authorized in §
33	13-7-403 and pay for the land at the price fixed by the court.
34	(c)(1) All suits for the condemnation of property under the provisions
35	of this subchapter shall be brought in the name of the State of Arkansas for
36	the use and benefit of the commission.

1	(2) Before any suit can be brought, it shall be necessary for
2	the commission to unanimously pass a resolution to that effect setting forth
3	the necessity and purpose for which the land is to be condemned, together
4	with the legal description of the lands sought to be condemned.
5	(3) A copy of the resolution shall then be transmitted to the
6	prosecuting attorney of the district in which the land is situated.
7	(4) It shall then be the duty of the prosecuting attorney to
8	institute proper proceedings for the condemnation of the land, or, if the
9	commission elects, it may employ its own counsel to institute condemnation
10	proceedings.
11	
12	13-7-405. Payment for land acquired.
13	(a) When the Prairie Grove Battlefield Commission shall have
14	ascertained the description of the lands to be acquired and shall have
15	satisfied itself as to the title thereto and the amount of payment to be made
16	to the owner or owners of the lands, the commission shall certify to the
17	Auditor of State its findings, giving the name of the landowner, the
18	description of the land involved, and the compensation due the landowner.
19	(b) When these facts shall have been certified to the Auditor of
20	State, the Auditor of State shall draw his or her warrant against the
21	appropriation made for that purpose for the amount due the landowner and the
22	Treasurer of State shall pay the amount of the warrant or voucher upon
23	presentation.
