23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. *REGULAR SALARIES - PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.* There is
26 hereby established for the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System for
27 the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees
28 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
29 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or
30 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
31 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
32 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
33 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
34 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
35 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. *EXTRA HELP - PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.* There is

1 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
3 FORWARD. The remaining balance as of June 30, ~~2004~~ 2006, of unexpended
4 ~~appropriation for the Agency Operations/Administration Program and available~~
5 ~~to be used for Operating Expense, up to \$765,393; Professional Fees, up to~~
6 ~~\$4,981,959; and Capital Outlay, up to 25,000~~ appropriation in Operating

18 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR
19 PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. EXEMPTION FROM PRIOR
20 REVIEW. The Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System is hereby exempted
21 from seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council with regard to
22 transfers between the Benefits line item in the Cash Fund Appropriation and
23 the Benefits-Non-Employee line item in the Operations Appropriation which are
24 specifically related to transfers necessitated by the changes in retirees'
25 selection of the method of payment of retirement benefits. All other
26 provisions of Arkansas Code §19-4-522 shall be applicable. The provisions of
27 this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2007.

28
29 SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
30 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
31 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
32 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
35 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
36 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

1 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

2
3 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
4 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
5 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
6 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
7 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
8 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
9 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
10 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

11
12 SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
13 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
14 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
15 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
16 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
17 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
18 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
19 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
20 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
21 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
22 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
