15 JUDICIAL DISTRICT WHILE HOLDING OFFICE; AND FOR

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 12, Subchapter 1 is amended
29 to add an additional section to read as follows:

30 16-12-102. Election of judges.

31 (a) Except as provided in § 16-12-106, all judges of the Court of
32 Appeals shall be elected for full eight-year terms.

33 (b) Each elected judge shall be a resident of the district from which
34 he is elected.

35 (c) A person appointed as a judge of the Court of Appeals shall not be



1 eligible to be a candidate for election to any Court of Appeals judgeship
2 while he or she is holding office.

4 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 13, Subchapter 1 is amended
5 to add an additional section to read as follows:

6 16-13-104. Appointed circuit judge – ineligibility as a candidate.

7 A person appointed as a circuit judge shall not be eligible to be a
8 candidate for election to any circuit judgeship in the same judicial district
9 in which he or she is holding office.
