AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE INSTITUTIONS  
OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION REAPPROPRIATION.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY - GENERAL  
24 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Henderson State University,  
25 to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund  
26 accounts, for the Henderson State University, the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
28 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 349 of 2003, for construction and equipping of a  
29 Henderson State University School of Business Building, in a sum not to

4 SECTION 44. REAPPROPRIATION - COSSATOT COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF THE UNIVERSITY  
5 OF ARKANSAS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Cossatot Community College  
6 of the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the General Improvement  
7 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Cossatot Community  
8 College of the University of Arkansas, the following:

9 (A) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
10 Item (A) of Section 16 of Act 626 of 2003, for critical  
11 maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed ....\$120,705.  
12

13 (B) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
14 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 467 of 2003, for purchasing, renovating,  
15 equipping, meeting life safety codes and meeting Americans with Disabilities  
16 Act requirements in the Nashville, Arkansas Technology Center, in a sum not  
17 to exceed .....\$100,757.  
18

19 (C) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
20 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 93 of 2003, for renovating, meeting American  
21 with Disabilities Act requirements and implementing safety in the structure  
22 known as the Collision Repair Facility on the DeQueen campus for use as a  
23 classroom for youth and adults, in a sum not to exceed .....\$19,421.  
24

25 SECTION 45. REAPPROPRIATION - BLACK RIVER TECHNICAL COLLEGE. There is  
26 hereby appropriated, to the Black River Technical College, to be payable from  
27 the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the  
28 Black River Technical College, the following:

29 (A) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
30 Item (B) of Section 35 of Act 349 of 2003, for construction, renovation and  
31 equipping of institutional facilities, in a sum not to exceed .....\$36,831.  
32

33 (B) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
34 Item (A) of Section 15 of Act 626 of 2003, for critical  
35 maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed ....\$125,000.  
36

1 (C) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
2 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1236 of 2003, for constructing and equipping a  
3 Distance Learning Laboratory, in a sum not to exceed .....\$150,000.  
4

5 SECTION 46. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION. There is  
6 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education, to be payable  
7 from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for  
8 the Department of Higher Education, the following:

9 (A) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
10 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 572 of 2003, for grant(s) for the operational  
11 costs of the Arkansas Association of Two-Year Colleges Workforce Training  
12 Consortium (WFTC), in a sum not to exceed .....\$118,450.  
13

14 (B) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
15 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1258 of 2003, for operations of the Technical  
16 Institute Study Commission, in a sum not to exceed .....\$49,454.  
17

18 (C) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
19 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 972 of 2003, for grants for the operational  
20 costs of the Career Assessment Consortium of the Arkansas Association of Two  
21 Year Colleges, in a sum not to exceed .....\$59,975.  
22

23 SECTION 47. REAPPROPRIATION - COLLEGE SAVINGS BOND PROGRAM. There is  
24 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education, to be payable  
25 from the Higher Education Projects Development Fund, for the Department of  
26 Higher Education, the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
28 Item (A) of Section 41 of Act 349 of 2003, for the development of projects at  
29 State Institutions of Higher Education and the payment of project costs and  
30 expenses of the issuance of bonds of the Arkansas College Savings General  
31 Obligation Bonds Program, in a sum not to exceed .....\$121,602.  
32

33 (B) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
34 Item (B) of Section 41 of Act 349 of 2003, for the development of projects at  
35 State Institutions of Higher Education and the payment of project costs and  
36 expenses of the issuance of bonds of the Arkansas College Savings General

1 Obligation Bonds Program, in a sum not to exceed .....\$3,485,740.

2

3 SECTION 48. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
4 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
5 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
6 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
7 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
8 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
9 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
10 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
11 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
12 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
13 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
14 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

15 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing  
16 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue  
17 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State  
18 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,  
19 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any  
20 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

21

22 SECTION 49. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
23 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
24 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
25 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
26 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
27 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
28 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
29 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

30

31 SECTION 50. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
32 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
33 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that previous  
34 General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the projects provided or  
35 enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will expire before the  
36 adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such appropriations expire,

1 the projects and programs authorized herein will cease thereby depriving the  
2 citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from such projects.  
3 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
4 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
5 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
6 passage and approval.

7 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
8 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
9 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
10 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides  
11 the veto.
