10 OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING
11 OFFICER FOR STATE ASSISTANCE TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS
12 IN BRADLEY, CALHOUN, AND UNION COUNTIES; AND FOR
13 OTHER PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
16 ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER -
17 FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN BRADLEY, CALHOUN,
18 AND UNION COUNTIES GENERAL IMPROVEMENT
19 APPROPRIATION.
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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN BRADLEY COUNTY, ARKANSAS.

27 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration
28 - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
29 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

30 (A) For state assistance to the Pleasantville Rural Fire Department in
31 Bradley, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

32 (B) For state assistance to the Sumpter Rural Fire Department in Bradley
33 County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

34 (C) For state assistance to the Bradley County Rural Fire Department in
35 Bradley County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.



1 (D) For state assistance to the County Line Rural Fire Department in
2 Bradley County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

3 (E) For state assistance to the Warren Fire Department in Bradley County,
4 Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

5 (F) For state assistance to the Jersey Rural Fire Department in Bradley
6 County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

7 (G) For state assistance to the Hermitage Volunteer Fire Department in
8 Bradley County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

9 (H) For state assistance to the Banks Volunteer Fire Department in Bradley
10 County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

11 (I) For state assistance to the Hermitage Rural Fire Department in Bradley
12 County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

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14 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN CALHOUN COUNTY, ARKANSAS.

15 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration
16 - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
17 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

18 (A) For state assistance to the Locust Bayou Volunteer Fire Department in
19 Calhoun County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

20 (B) For state assistance to the Harrell Volunteer Fire Department in
21 Calhoun County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

22 (C) For state assistance to the Hampton Fire Department in Calhoun County,
23 Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

24 (D) For state assistance to the Caney Creek Fire Department in Calhoun
25 County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

26 (E) For state assistance to the Chambersville Volunteer Fire Department in
27 Calhoun County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

28 (F) For state assistance to the Thornton Fire Department in Calhoun
29 County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

30 (G) For state assistance to the Tinsman Volunteer Fire Department in
31 Calhoun County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

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33 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN UNION COUNTY, ARKANSAS.

34 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration
35 - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
36 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

1 (A) For state assistance to the Strong Volunteer Fire Department in Union
2 County, Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

3 (B) For state assistance to the Huttig Fire Department in Union County,
4 Arkansas, the sum of\$10,000.

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6 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
7 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
8 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
9 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
10 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
11 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
12 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
13 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
14 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
15 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
16 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
17 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

18 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
19 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
20 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
21 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
22 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
23 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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25 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
26 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
27 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
28 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
29 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
30 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
31 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
32 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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34 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
35 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
36 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the

1 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
2 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
3 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
4 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
5 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
6 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
7 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
8 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
