16 AN ACT FOR THE STATE DEPARTMENT FOR  
17 SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION  
18 DISABILITY DETERMINATION APPROPRIATION  
19 FOR THE 2005-2007 BIENNIUM.  
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State  
26 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for  
27 the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees  
28 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform  
29 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or  
30 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any  
31 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in  
32 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
33 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
34 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
35 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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10 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State  
 11 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for  
 12 the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or  
 13 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds  
 14 appropriated herein for such purposes: twenty (20) temporary or part-time  
 15 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
 16 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act  
 17 for the appropriate classification.

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19 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to  
 20 the State Department for Social Security Administration Disability  
 21 Determination, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the  
 22 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services and operating  
 23 expenses of the State Department for Social Security Administration  
 24 Disability Determination for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the  
 25 following:

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5 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA  
7 HELP RESTRICTION. No extra help employee of Disability Determination for  
8 Social Security Administration shall be employed for a period of time to  
9 exceed eighteen hundred (1800) hours in any single fiscal year.

10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005  
11 through June 30, 2007.

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13 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE  
14 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD.  
15 The remaining balance as of June 30, 2006, of unexpended appropriation in  
16 Capital Outlay shall be carried forward into fiscal year  
17 2006-07 to be used for the same purpose for the next fiscal year. The  
18 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 through  
19 June 30, 2007.

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21 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
22 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
23 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
24 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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31 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
32 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
33 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
34 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
35 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
36 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
2 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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4 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
5 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
6 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
7 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of  
8 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
9 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
10 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the  
11 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
12 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
13 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
14 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
