24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25

26 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
27 Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Child Support
28 Enforcement for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of
29 regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
30 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
31 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
32 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
33 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
34 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
35 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular

2 successor.

25 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of
 26 Finance and Administration - Office of Child Support Enforcement for the
 27 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 28 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 29 herein for such purposes: fifteen (15) temporary or part-time employees,
 30 when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform
 31 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the
 32 appropriate classification.

34 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to
 35 the Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Child Support
 36 Enforcement, to be payable from the Child Support Enforcement Fund, for

1 personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Finance and
 2 Administration - Office of Child Support Enforcement - Operations for the
 3 biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

19 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA
 21 HELP EXEMPTION. Extra Help positions authorized herein are specifically
 22 exempt from limitation of hours, either by act or regulation. Provided,
 23 however, when a temporary or part-time employee is employed by the Department
 24 of Finance and Administration-Revenue Services- Office of Child Support
 25 Enforcement for a period of time exceeding seven (7) months, a report of such
 26 shall be filed with the Legislative Council. The provisions of this section
 27 shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

29 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 30 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 31 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 32 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 35 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 36 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

1 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

2
3 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
4 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
5 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
6 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
7 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
8 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
9 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
10 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

11
12 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
13 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
14 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
15 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
16 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
17 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
18 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
19 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
20 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
21 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
22 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
