23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 17, Subchapter 1 is amended
26 to add an additional section to read as follows:

27 16-17-135. Counties authorized to employ and compensate district court
28 judges as criminal magistrates.

29 (a)(1) A county may employ one (1) or more district court judges to
30 act as criminal magistrates in accordance with the provisions of Rule 1.8(a)
31 of the Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure or in accordance with per curiam
32 orders issued by the Arkansas Supreme Court.

33 (2) A district court judge acting as a criminal magistrate may
34 be authorized to perform any of the duties described in Rule 1.8(b) of the
35 Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure.
