## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATING  
10 EXPENSES AND CONSTRUCTION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
11 ARKANSAS STATE POLICE - ARKANSAS WIRELESS  
12 INFORMATION NETWORK SYSTEM WHICH SHALL BE  
13 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS  
14 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1609 OF 2003; AND FOR OTHER  
15 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

18 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS  
19 STATE POLICE - ARKANSAS WIRELESS  
20 INFORMATION NETWORK SYSTEM SUPPLEMENTAL  
21 APPROPRIATION.  
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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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27 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - AWIN SYSTEM. There is hereby appropriated, to  
28 the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be payable from the federal funds  
29 as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating  
30 expenses and construction of the Department of Arkansas State Police -  
31 Arkansas Wireless Information Network System which shall be supplemental and  
32 in addition to those funds appropriated in Act 1609 of 2003, the following:

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10 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 11 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 12 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 13 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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20 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 21 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 22 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 23 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 24 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 26 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 27 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 30 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of  
 31 the Department of Arkansas State Police are, due to unforeseen circumstances,  
 32 insufficient for the Department of Arkansas State Police to continue to  
 33 provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will  
 34 provide the necessary monies for the Department of Arkansas State Police to  
 35 continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act  
 36 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of

essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
