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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State
24 Military Department for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number
25 of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of
26 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
27 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
28 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
29 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
30 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
33 successor.

There is hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the Military Support Revolving Fund, for vehicle insurance, supplies, rations, fuel, personnel service, allowances, equipment leases, and various active duty status, operational support and related operating expenses of the State Military Department for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

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SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CIVILIAN STUDENT TRAINING PROGRAM TRANSPORTATION. Transportation to support Civilian Student Training program activities for juvenile participants and staff may be provided by commercial lease/purchase of motor vehicles not to exceed six vehicles at Camp Joseph T. Robinson.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YOUTH CHALLENGE PROGRAM - STIPENDS. Juvenile participants in the Arkansas National Guard Youth Challenge Program at Camp Joseph T. Robinson receiving services from the Arkansas National Guard are authorized to receive a monetary stipend, not to exceed fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per week to defray personal hygiene and other personal necessities, and a monetary stipend not to exceed two thousand two hundred dollars (\$2,200) upon graduation from the program to defray costs for additional job training or education. Juvenile participants are authorized to receive uniforms and clothing items as determined by the staff to be appropriate for effective participation in outdoor activities.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YOUTH CHALLENGE PROGRAM TRANSPORTATION. Transportation to support Arkansas National Guard Youth Challenge Program activities for juvenile participants and staff may be provided by commercial lease/purchase of motor vehicles not to exceed six vehicles.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MILITARY
2 SUPPORT REVOLVING FUND.

3 (a)(1) There is created within the Military Department a revolving fund
4 which shall be designated the Military Support Revolving Fund into which
5 shall be transferred or deposited the moneys to be provided by law for the
6 fund.

7 (2) The fund shall be used by the Military Department to pay
8 reimbursements for periodic, short term personnel augmentation for National
9 Guard Members on State Active Duty for cost incurred in training activities,
10 which shall include but not be limited to goods, supplies, rations, fuel,
11 operating expenses and related costs and expenses.

12 (b) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor
13 of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, a fund to be known as the
14 Military Support Revolving Fund. The fund shall consist of:

15 (1) All funds provided for by law for the fund;

16 (2) All moneys received by the Military Department from the United
17 States Army, United States Air Force, United States Navy, Foreign Allied
18 Governments, and Reserve Forces of the United States, Allied Nations and
19 other federal agencies; and,

20 (3) Any and all reimbursements and payments to this fund from any
21 source shall be considered a refund to expenditures.

22 (4) As federal reimbursements replenish this fund, the Agency is
23 authorized to return funds, as necessary, to the Special Military Fund.
24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005
25 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

27 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
29 FORWARD. At the close of each fiscal year, the Director of the State Military
30 Department shall certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State the amount,
31 if any, of unexpended federal funds for the State Military Department - Youth
32 Challenge Program remaining in the State Military Department Fund. Such
33 amounts, shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose in
34 the next succeeding fiscal year. The provisions of this section shall be in

SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA HELP. No employee of the Camp J.T. Robinson, or Fort Chaffee Federal Training Site Divisions of the Military Department who is employed as "extra help" may receive an amount to exceed eighty-five percent (85%) of the maximum annual salary for a comparable position as authorized under Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor shall such employee be employed for a period of time to exceed eighteen hundred (1800) hours in any single fiscal year.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 ~~2005~~, through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARTELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL, AND TEMPORARY LAW. HAZARDOUS DUTY PAY. The State Military Department is hereby authorized to pay hazardous duty pay to provide special compensation to eligible firefighting personnel to compensate for the increased risk of personal injury and occupational exposure. The hazardous duty pay authorized herein shall be an amount equal to five and one-half percent (5.5%) of the annual salary authorized by law to any eligible employee and shall only be made available to the personnel occupying the following positions.

Only employees in the above classifications who are one-hundred percent (100%) federally funded and state administered are authorized to receive the hazardous duty pay allowance in an amount of five and one-half percent (5.5%) of the annual salary authorized by law.

The amounts received under the provisions of this section shall not be considered as exceeding the maximum authorized annual salary allowance for employees in receipt of such amounts. Such amounts shall be considered as Regular Salary and the Department of Finance and Administration shall adopt

1 the necessary rules and regulations for the administration of this provision.
2 Employees covered by the provisions of this Section shall be eligible for
3 special compensation for hazardous duty only upon a determination by the
4 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State that sufficient federal revenues that fund
5 these positions are available to sustain payment of the additional
6 compensation levels herein authorized. It is the intent of this section that
7 such payments shall be mandatory so long as sufficient federal revenues that
8 fund these positions exist and shall not be implemented using funds
9 specifically set aside for other programs within the Department.

10
11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005
12 through June 30, 2007.

13
14 SECTION 23. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
15 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
16 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
17 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
18 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
19 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
20 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
22 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

23
24 SECTION 24. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
25 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
26 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
27 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
28 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
29 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
30 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
31 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

32
33 SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
34 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
35 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
36 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of

1 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
2 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
3 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
4 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
5 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
6 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
7 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
