22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23
24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Arkansas State Police for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following
26 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
30 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
31 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
32 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
33 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
34 or its successor.

25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COURT
26 AWARDS FUND – MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. Monies deposited in the
27 Court Awards Fund each fiscal year shall be used exclusively for motor
28 vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or motor vehicle renovation costs
29 for the Department of Arkansas State Police.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~
31 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

33 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR
35 VEHICLE ACQUISITION REVOLVING FUND - MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. At
36 least fifty percent (50%) of the general revenues deposited each fiscal year

1 into the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be used for motor
2 vehicle purchases and or motor vehicle renovation costs for the Department of
3 Arkansas State Police.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~
5 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

6
7 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
9 PROVISION. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized,
10 after seeking the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior
11 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to
12 *request transfer from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds*
13 *Transfer" to the Capital Outlay line item contained in the operations*
14 *appropriation of the Department of Arkansas State Police, and shall be used*
15 *exclusively for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or motor*
16 *vehicle renovation costs for the Department of Arkansas State Police; and to*
17 request fund transfers from the Court Awards Fund to the Department of
18 Arkansas State Police Fund *in the same amount and for the same purposes as*
19 *the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this section.*
20 Further provided, the Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
21 authorized to request a fund transfer from the Court Awards Fund or the
22 Arkansas State Police Fund to the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund.
23 Fund transfers to the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be
24 reported to the Arkansas Legislative Council, but do not require prior

35 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME.

1 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime
2 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to
3 those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be
4 assigned by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police to
5 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable
6 to Arkansas State Police by federal or local authorities as approved by the
7 Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police. All such overtime
8 payments shall be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be
9 in addition to the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee.

10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003

13 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

15 VEHICLE PURCHASE. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
16 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for
17 *Capital Outlay in the State Police Operations* appropriation in this Act.
18 Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police and confiscated vehicles
19 used for Arkansas State Police operations shall not be included in the
20 maximum number of authorized passenger vehicles.

24 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORM
26 EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas
27 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer
28 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
29 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee
30 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the
31 beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims
32 paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined
33 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance
34 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the
35 department, the ~~84th~~ 85th General Assembly shall study the feasibility and
36 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide

1 medical and hospital insurance to uniform employees through the public

6 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

8 BALANCES - STATE POLICE EQUIPMENT FUND. (A) For all appropriations as
9 provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level
10 of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any
11 proposed expenditures would cause the State Police Equipment Fund to decline
12 below one million three hundred eighty eight thousand eight hundred thirty
13 five dollars (\$1,388,835), the disbursing officer shall immediately notify
14 the executive head of the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under
15 these circumstances, the agency head shall file written documentation with
16 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting approval of the
17 expenditures. Such documentation shall provide sufficient financial data to
18 justify the expenditures and shall include the following:

- 19 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
20 expenditures on the fund balance.
21 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut

23 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
24 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
25 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not

28 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
29 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
30 prior review by the Legislative Council.

34 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

36 RATES OF PAY. Due to the necessity of maintaining public safety and the

1 highly competitive job market conditions for law enforcement personnel, the
 2 Arkansas State Police is authorized special rates of pay for current and new
 3 employees up to the levels listed below:

8 Commissioned employees who are hired as State Police Troopers will be
 9 considered Recruits within the grade 19 classification and shall ~~remain at~~
 10 ~~Pay Level I until the successful completion of recruit school. These~~
 11 ~~employees will then be considered Trainees for the next 12 months of~~
 12 ~~employment and shall be eligible for a salary adjustment not to exceed a rate~~
 13 ~~that is equal to fifty percent (50%) of the range between Pay Level I and Pay~~
 14 ~~Level II of grade 19. After satisfactory completion of 12 months of~~
 15 ~~employment as a Trainee, the Trainee will become eligible for promotion to~~
 16 ~~State Police Trooper and shall be eligible for salary adjustments up to Pay~~
 17 ~~Level II of the grade 19.~~ be eligible for additional compensation at the
 18 successful completion of six months of service. These employees will then be
 19 considered trainees for the next 12 months and at the end of 18 months of
 20 total service shall be eligible for a salary adjustment not to exceed Pay
 21 Level IIM.

22 Current commissioned uniform employees whose salaries were awarded a one
 23 time adjustment by Act 1609 of 2003 and whose salaries exceed Pay Level IV,
 24 shall not be considered as exceeding the line item maximum of the employee's
 25 assigned grade.

26 After completion of four and a half years of employment the Commissioned
 27 employee will be eligible for promotion to Trooper First Class, grade 20.
 28 After seven and a half years of employment, the employee will be eligible for
 29 promotion to Corporal, grade 21. Employees will be eligible for normal
 30 promotion increases as they advance to the classifications of Sergeant,
 31 Lieutenant, Captain, and Major. Any disciplinary actions taken against an
 32 *employee may delay the promotional process.*

 16 SECTION 22. APPROPRIATION ARKANSAS STATE POLICE – CASH. There is hereby
 17 appropriated, to the Arkansas State Police, to be payable from the cash fund
 18 deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
 19 the State, for construction of an airport hanger for the biennial period
 20 ending June 30, 2007, the sum of\$200,000.

21
 22 SECTION 23. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 23 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 24 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 25 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 26 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 27 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 28 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 29 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 30 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

 32 SECTION 24. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 33 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 34 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 35 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 36 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by

1 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
2 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
3 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

5 SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
6 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
7 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
8 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
9 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
10 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
11 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
12 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
13 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
14 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
15 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
