12 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS REVENUE
13 STABILIZATION LAW.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §19-5-205(e)(1)(B) is amended by adding the
20 following new subsections to reflect current sources of revenue for the State
21 Central Services Fund to read as follows:

22 (xvi) That portion of non-refundable fees charged by bail bond companies for
23 the Arkansas Public Defender Commission, §17-19-301(e);

24 (xvii) The first one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) collected in taxes
25 and penalties under § 26-26-1614 and deposited as non-revenue receipts during
26 each fiscal year, for use by the Revenue Division of the Department of
27 Finance and Administration, §26-26-1616.
28

29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code §19-5-205(e)(1)(B)(i) concerning sources of
30 special revenue for the State Central Services Fund, is amended to read as
31 follows:

32 (i) Those special revenues as specified in subdivisions (9), (11), (19),
33 (21), (37), (75), (76), (77), (78), (79), (82), (83), (84), (85), (86), (87),
34 (88), (89), (91), (96), (116), (118), (120), (124), (149), and (188), and ~~ten~~
35 eight percent (10%) (8%) of those special revenues as set out in §19-6-



1 301(20) of the Revenue Classification Law, §19-6-101 et seq.;

3 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code §19-5-303 is amended by adding the following
4 new section concerning the establishment of an institution of higher
5 education general revenue fund to read as follows:

6 (ff)(1) School for Math, Science and Arts Fund. There is established
7 on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal
8 Officer of the State a fund to be known as the "School for Math, Science and
9 Arts Fund".

10 (2) The fund shall consist of:

11 (A) Moneys allocated and transferred from the Educational Excellence
12 Trust Fund;

13 (B) Any general revenues as may be provided by the Revenue
14 Stabilization Law, §19-5-101 et seq.; and

15 (C) Any other monies as may be authorized by law.

16 (3) The fund shall be used to provide for the maintenance, operation
17 and improvement required by the Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences and
18 the Arts in carrying out its powers, functions and duties as set out by law.

19
20 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code §19-5-307(b)(1) concerning sources of special
21 revenues for the Public Health Fund, is amended to read as follows:

22 (1) Those special revenues as set out in subdivisions (65), (68), (69), (80),
23 (97), (131), (132), (133), (136), (137), (140), (141), (142), (143), (144),
24 (147), (155), (166), (177), ~~(178)~~, (194), (204), (205), (208) of §19-6-301
25 and that portion of §19-6-301(58) of the Revenue Classification Law §19-6-101
26 et seq.;

27
28 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code §19-5-308 is amended to read as follows:

29 ~~19-5-308. State Building Services~~ Arkansas Building Authority Account.
30 There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of
31 State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State an account to be known as
32 the ~~State Building Services~~ Arkansas Building Authority Account of the
33 General Improvement Fund. This account shall consist of funds authorized for
34 deposit in the State Treasury by the General Assembly. It shall be used for
35 the purposes authorized and required by the Arkansas ~~State Building Services~~
36 Building Authority Act, §§ 22-2-101 - 22-2-120.

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SECTION 6. Arkansas Code §19-5-602(a)(3), concerning sources of special revenues for the County Aid Fund, is amended to read as follows:

(3) Those special revenues as set out in subdivisions (74) and (117) and ~~forty five percent (45%)~~ thirty-four percent (34%) of those special revenues as specified in subdivision (20) of §19-6-301 of the Revenue Classification Law, §19-6-101 et seq.; and

SECTION 7. Arkansas Code §19-5-1046 is amended to read as follows:

19-5-1046. Arkansas ~~State Building Services~~ Authority Maintenance Fund.

(a) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as the Arkansas ~~State Building Services~~ Authority Maintenance Fund, which shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement of lands, buildings, and facilities that may be acquired by the Arkansas ~~State Building Services~~ Authority.

(b)(1) The Arkansas ~~State Building Services~~ Authority Maintenance Fund shall consist of all moneys received in connection with the leasing, management, and operation of building facilities and lands belonging to or managed by Arkansas ~~State Building Services~~ Authority.

(2) The moneys received by Arkansas ~~State Building Services~~ Authority are declared to be non-revenue receipts.

SECTION 8. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 11 is amended by adding the following new sections concerning the establishment of trust funds to read as follows:

19-5-1127. Arkansas Multi-Agency Insurance Trust Fund.

(a) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a trust fund to be known as the Arkansas Multi-Agency Insurance Trust Fund.

(b) The fund shall consist of all moneys received by the Administrator of the Risk Management Division of the State Insurance Department, including, but not limited to, the premiums collected and any insured loss or loss expenses paid by insurance or reinsurance companies and interest income as set out in §25-35-103.

(c) The fund shall be used for the purposes as set out in §25-35-103.

2 19-5-1128. Organ Donor Awareness Education Trust Fund.

3 (a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of
4 State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a trust fund to be known as
5 the Organ Donor Awareness Education Trust Fund.

6 (b) The fund shall consist of all moneys donated or collected for the
7 purpose of educating or informing the public of the need for organ donations,
8 all interest earned from the investment of fund balances, and any remaining
9 fund balances carried forward from year to year, and any gifts, grants,
10 bequests, devises and donations.

11 (c) The fund shall be used for educational or informational materials and
12 other related costs associated with informing or educating the public about
13 organ donations and organ donation awareness as set out in §20-17-502.

15 19-5-1129. Economic Development Superprojects Project Fund.

16 (a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of
17 State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a trust fund to be known as
18 the Economic Development Superprojects Project Fund.

19 (b) The fund shall consist of the proceeds from the sale of bonds, together
20 with all revenues derived by the Arkansas Development Finance Authority from
21 any superproject financed or refinanced under §15-4-3012.

22 (c) This fund shall be used to provide for payment of all or a part of debt
23 service on bonds and to directly fund superprojects on a pay-as-you-go basis
24 as set out in §15-4-3012.

25

26 *SECTION 9. Arkansas Code 19-5-302(10) concerning the Miscellaneous*
27 *Agencies Fund Account is amended to read as follows:*

28 *(10)(A) Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account. The Miscellaneous Agencies Fund*
29 *Account may be used for the state's membership in regional or national*
30 *associations, grants to certain organizations, and maintenance, operations,*
31 *and improvements of appropriation units as may be authorized by the General*
32 *Assembly.*

33 *(B) The Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account shall consist of:*

34 *(i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;*

35 *(ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the*
36 *various agencies and programs funded from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund*

1 Account; and

2 (iii) Federal reimbursement received on account of eligible
3 expenditures of the various agencies and programs receiving primary support
4 from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account.

5 ~~(C)(i) In the event that the amount of funds estimated to be available
6 for the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account is less than the total of the
7 appropriations made from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, the Chief
8 Fiscal Officer of the State shall determine the amount of each appropriation
9 to be financed after full funding is provided for all national and regional
10 association dues by using the following procedure:~~

11 ~~(a) Determine from each appropriation the lesser of the estimated
12 expenditures for the fiscal year preceding the fiscal year from which the
13 funding level is to be determined and the amount of the appropriation for the
14 fiscal year for which the funding level is to be determined. This result
15 shall be called the "base appropriation";~~

16 ~~(b) From the amount determined in subdivision (10)(C)(i)(a) of this
17 section subtract the amount appropriated for the fiscal year for which the
18 funding level is to be determined. This result shall be called the
19 "improvement level";~~

20 ~~(c) The sum of the amounts determined in (10)(c)(i)(a) of this section
21 shall be subtracted from the estimated amount to be available for the
22 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account;~~

23 ~~(d) If the amount estimated to be available for the Miscellaneous
24 Agencies Fund Account is less than the sum of all base appropriations, then
25 the amount of funding to be made available to each appropriation shall be
26 determined by multiplying each appropriation's base appropriation percentage
27 of the sum of all base appropriations by the amount estimated to be available
28 for the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account; and~~

29 ~~(e) If the amount estimated to be available for the Miscellaneous
30 Agencies Fund Account is greater than the sum of all base appropriations,
31 each appropriation shall first receive full funding of its base appropriation
32 and then it's proportionate share of the amounts determined in subdivision
33 (10)(C)(i)(b) of this section based upon the total of all improvement levels.~~

34 ~~(ii) Upon completing the procedure in subdivision (10)(C)(i)(a) —
35 (d) of this section, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall notify the
36 Legislative Council.~~

1 ~~(iii) However, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall~~
2 ~~determine for any appropriation authorized for a biennial period the portion~~
3 ~~of the biennial appropriation that shall be used in the computations as the~~
4 ~~base appropriation and that portion shall be used as the improvement level.~~

5 ~~(D)(i) The Department of Finance and Administration may upon approval~~
6 ~~of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council or the~~
7 ~~Joint Budget Committee transfer any savings that may accrue in any fiscal~~
8 ~~year in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account to the Department of Rural~~
9 ~~Services of the Arkansas Rural Development Commission, the Arkansas Science~~
10 ~~and Technology Authority, the Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation~~
11 ~~Commission, and the Arkansas Spinal Cord Commission.~~

12 ~~(ii) The transfer is to enable those agencies to fund critical needs of~~
13 ~~grant and service recipients across the state with the savings from other~~
14 ~~agencies funded by the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account.~~

15 ~~(E)(i) Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum~~
16 ~~amount of appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each~~
17 ~~fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually~~
18 ~~accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation act or acts~~
19 ~~for a state agency and the general revenue allocations authorized for each~~
20 ~~fund and fund account by amendment to this chapter.~~

21 ~~(ii) The General Assembly has determined that the Department of Finance~~
22 ~~and Administration may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is~~
23 ~~provided to the Department of Finance and Administration by authorizing broad~~
24 ~~powers under this subdivision (10). Therefore, it is both necessary and~~
25 ~~appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior~~
26 ~~approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by~~
27 ~~this subdivision (10).~~

28 ~~(iii) The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint~~
29 ~~Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement~~
30 ~~of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled~~
31 ~~unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is~~
32 ~~void.~~

33 (C) If there are not sufficient funds available in the Miscellaneous
34 Agencies Fund Account to support the amounts appropriated from the
35 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
36 shall determine the amount of moneys to be made available for each of the

1 appropriations made from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, after
2 having first provided full funding for all national and regional association
3 dues.

5 SECTION 10. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
6 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. Section 3 of Uncodified Act
7 108 of the 2nd Ex. Sess., 2003 is amended to read as follows:

8 Section 3. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
9 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. On June 30, 2005, the Chief
10 Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the
11 State Treasurer and the State Auditor the sum of ~~twenty two million dollars~~
12 ~~(\$22,000,000)~~ forty nine million dollars (\$49,000,000), or so much thereof as
13 is available, from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund, from monies
14 transferred due to the provisions of Arkansas Code 19-5-406 for the 2004-05
15 fiscal year, to the Educational Adequacy Fund.

16
17 SECTION 11. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
18 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PROPERTY TAX RELIEF
19 TRANSFER. (a) Of the balance remaining in the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund
20 on December 31, 2005 and December 31, 2006, as certified pursuant to § 26-26-
21 310(b)(2)(C), the Treasurer of State shall transfer eighteen million one
22 hundred fifty three thousand six dollars (\$18,153,006) for the fiscal year
23 ending June 30, 2006 from the balance remaining on December 31, 2005 and
24 twenty two million dollars (\$22,000,000) for the fiscal year ending June 20,
25 2007 from the balance remaining on December 31, 2006, from the Property Tax
26 Relief Trust Fund to the General Revenue Fund Account of the State
27 Apportionment Fund as "general revenues available for distribution" as
28 provided in Arkansas Code 19-5-202(b)(2)(B)(iii).

29 (b) The funds attributable to sales and use taxes levied prior to July
30 1, 2005 shall not be transferred from the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund to
31 the General Revenue Fund Account of the State Apportionment Fund.

32
33 SECTION 12. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
34 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SET ASIDE OF FUNDS. The Chief
35 Fiscal Officer of the State shall immediately set aside the sum of eighty
36 four million dollars (\$84,000,000) of those unobligated monies in the General

1 Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund. On July 1, 2005, the Chief Fiscal Officer of
2 the State shall transfer the sum of fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000) from
3 the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the Educational Facilities
4 Partnership Fund Account to provide funding for those appropriations made
5 from the fund account. On July 1, 2006, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
6 shall transfer the sum of thirty four million dollars (\$34,000,000) from the
7 General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the General Revenue Fund Account of
8 the State Apportionment Fund, there to be distributed as other general
9 revenues for the 2006-07 fiscal year.

11 SECTION 13. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
12 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS EMPLOYMENT SECURITY
13 DEPARTMENT APPROPRIATIONS. In the event enabling legislation is enacted by
14 the Eighty-Fifth General Assembly changing the name of the agency, any
15 appropriations made payable to the Arkansas Employment Security Department
16 are instead deemed appropriated to the Department of Workforce Services.

17
18 SECTION 14. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
19 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. POST PRISON TRANSFER BOARD
20 APPROPRIATIONS. Any appropriations made payable to the Post Prison Transfer
21 Board are instead deemed appropriated to the Parole Board.

22
23 SECTION 15. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
24 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS SOIL AND WATER
25 CONSERVATION COMMISSION APPROPRIATIONS. Any appropriations made payable to
26 the Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation Commission are instead deemed
27 appropriated to the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission.

28
29 SECTION 16. Arkansas Code 19-5-401 is amended to read as follows:
30 19-5-401. Allocations for fiscal year 2005-06.
31 Commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30,
32 2006, the Treasurer of State shall transfer all remaining general revenues
33 available for distribution on the last day of business in July 2005, and on
34 the last day of business in each calendar month thereafter during the fiscal
35 year to the various funds and fund accounts participating in general revenues
36 in the proportions of the maximum allocation as the individual allocation to

1 the fund or fund account bears to the total of the maximum allocation as
 2 provided in § 19-5-402(a) and (b).

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12 SECTION 20. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by
