9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE STATE  
11 BANK DEPARTMENT FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING  
12 JUNE 30, 2007; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE STATE BANK DEPARTMENT  
16 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2005-2007

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State  
24 Bank Department for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of  
25 regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the  
26 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et  
27 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,  
28 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein  
29 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
30 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
33 successor.

20 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State Bank  
 21 Department for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of part-  
 22 time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds  
 23 appropriated herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time  
 24 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
 25 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act  
 26 for the appropriate classification.

27

28 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to  
 29 the State Bank Department, to be payable from the Bank Department Fund, for  
 30 personal services and operating expenses of the State Bank Department for the  
 31 biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

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10 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL  
 12 RATES OF PAY. Due to the highly competitive job market conditions for banking  
 13 industry professionals and the necessity of recruiting and retaining  
 14 qualified personnel, the State Bank Department is authorized special rates of  
 15 pay for current and new employees up to the levels listed under subsection  
 16 (a), with additional authority and restrictions as indicated in subsections  
 17 (b) and (c) below:

18 (a) Special rates may be authorized for the following classifications  
 19 only, as indicated herein.

31 (b) Applications for special rates of pay indicated in subsection (a) shall  
 32 have been reviewed and approved by the Office of Personnel Management after  
 33 prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council.

34 (c) Labor market rates will be established as needed for classifications  
 35 not covered by the provisions of this section.

36 (d) A current plan of progression should be filed with the Office of

1 Personnel Management on a biennial basis.  
2 This special provision shall be in full force and effect for the biennium  
3 beginning July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005 and ending June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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5 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
7 BALANCES - BANK DEPARTMENT FUND. (A) For all appropriations as provided in  
8 this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level of fund  
9 balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed  
10 expenditures would cause the Bank Department Fund to decline below six  
11 hundred forty six thousand two hundred and eighty six dollars (\$646,286), the  
12 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.  
13 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency  
14 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the  
15 State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall  
16 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall  
17 include the following:

- 18 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such  
19 expenditures on the fund balance.
- 20 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut  
21 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
- 22 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs  
23 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 24 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not  
25 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent  
26 depletion of the fund balance.

27 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and  
28 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought  
29 prior review by the Legislative Council.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~  
31 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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33 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
34 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
35 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
36 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
3 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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7 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
8 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
9 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
10 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
11 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
12 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
13 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
14 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
17 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
18 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of  
20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
21 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
22 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the  
23 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
24 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
25 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
26 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
