34 SECTION 26. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CLAIMS  
36 FROM CASH FUNDS. In the event that any claim authorized herein is determined

1 to be a valid claim against the State and the claim is to be paid from funds  
2 not in the State Treasury, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall  
3 notify the agency against which the claim is to be charged of the amount of  
4 such claims. Upon receipt of such notification, the state agency shall  
5 forthwith deliver a check to the Clerk of the State Claims Commission who  
6 shall deposit the same as a non-revenue receipt into the Miscellaneous  
7 Revolving Fund from which he shall disburse the amount of the claim to the  
8 claimant.

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10 SECTION 27. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
12 EMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION CLAIMS. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission  
13 shall not distribute any warrants prepared under the provisions of this Act  
14 for awards made by the Arkansas State Claims Commission for employment  
15 compensation claims. Upon the award by the State Claims Commission of an  
16 employment compensation claim, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall  
17 notify the affected state agency and the Department of Finance and  
18 Administration - Office of Personnel Management of such amounts that are due  
19 and payable. The affected state agency shall then process the award through  
20 the State Mechanized Payroll System.

21

22 SECTION 28. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CLAIMS  
24 AWARD REPORTING. It is the intent of the General Assembly that when any state  
25 agency, board, commission or institution of higher education admits liability  
26 to a claim filed with the State Claims Commission and the claim involves a  
27 contract with a state agency, board, commission or institution of higher  
28 education or the claim exceeds ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) that such  
29 agency, board, commission or institution of higher education file a written  
30 report thereof to the Litigation Subcommittee of the Legislative Council.  
31 Such a report shall include a concise statement of facts with an explanation  
32 of the agency's liability. Provided further, such report shall be filed with  
33 the Litigation Subcommittee within thirty (30) days after the claim has been  
34 adjudicated by the State Claims Commission.

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36 SECTION 29. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE, NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PURCHASE  
2 OF ANNUITY. Of the funds appropriated in Section 12, Item (02) shall be for  
3 the sole purpose of purchasing an annuity for the benefit of Michael James  
4 Cline, minor child of Tina Franklin and Roy Cline, Jr. who filed a claim  
5 against the University of Arkansas – Medical Sciences with the Arkansas State  
6 Claims Commission in 1998. The claim was settled without admission of  
7 liability from the University of Arkansas – Medical Sciences. The University  
8 of Arkansas – Medical Sciences agreed to pay, and Tina and Roy Franklin, Jr.  
9 agreed to accept, a total settlement in the amount of one hundred fifty  
10 thousand dollars (\$150,000). The University of Arkansas – Medical Sciences,  
11 Tina Franklin and Roy Cline, Jr. agreed that it is in the best interest of  
12 Michael James Cline for seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) of the agreed  
13 settlement to be expended on the purchase of an annuity for Michael James  
14 Cline. The Clerk of the Arkansas State Claim Commission, the Chief Fiscal  
15 Officer of the State and the Auditor of State shall effectuate the issuance  
16 of a warrant to American General Annuity Services Corporation in the amount  
17 of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000), along with payment of seventy-  
18 five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to Tina Franklin and Roy Cline, Jr., as  
19 parents and guardians of Michael James Cline, a minor.

20  
21 SECTION 30. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
22 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
23 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
24 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

30  
31 SECTION 31. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
32 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
33 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
34 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
35 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
36 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
2 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

3  
4 SECTION 32. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
5 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
6 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
7 effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is  
8 essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this  
9 Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular  
10 Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its  
11 passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper  
12 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,  
13 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the  
14 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in  
15 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

16 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
17 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
18 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
