21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-73-313 is amended to read as follows:
24 5-73-313. Expiration and renewal.

25 (a) No less than ninety (90) days prior to the expiration date of the
26 license, the Department of Arkansas State Police shall mail to each licensee
27 a written notice of the expiration ~~and a renewal form prescribed by the~~
28 ~~Department of Arkansas State Police.~~

29 (b) The licensee must renew his license on or before the expiration
30 date by filing with the Department of Arkansas State Police:

31 (1) the A renewal form prescribed by the Department of Arkansas
32 State Police;

33 (2) a A notarized affidavit stating that the licensee remains
34 qualified pursuant to the criteria specified in §§ 5-73-308(a) and 5-73-309;
35 and



1 (3) a A renewal fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00).

2 (c) The license shall be renewed upon receipt of the completed renewal
3 application and appropriate payment of fees subject to a background
4 investigation conducted pursuant to § 5-73-311.

5 (d) Additionally, a licensee who fails to file a renewal application
6 on or before its expiration date must renew his license by paying a late fee
7 of fifteen dollars (\$15.00).

8 (e)(1) No license shall be renewed six (6) months or more after its
9 expiration date, and such license shall be deemed to be permanently expired.

10 (2) A person whose license has been permanently expired may
11 reapply for licensure; however, an application for licensure and fees
12 pursuant to §§ 5-73-308(a), 5-73-309, and 5-73-311(a) must be submitted, and
13 a new background investigation shall be conducted.

14 (f) A new criminal background investigation shall be conducted when an
15 applicant applies for renewal of a license.

16 (g) Active duty military personnel and reservists on active duty who
17 submit documentation of their active duty status shall be exempt from the
18 training requirements under subsection (b) of this section.
