20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-90-119 is amended to read as follows:
23 16-90-119. Confiscation ~~and destruction~~ of deadly weapons.

24 (a) When any person is convicted of any homicide, burglary, robbery,
25 assault with intent to kill, assault with a deadly weapon, battery, or any
26 other felony involving a deadly weapon, the court in which the person is
27 convicted may confiscate the deadly weapons involved in the offense and may
28 by court order either:

29 (1) ~~transfer~~ Transfer the weapons and the title to the weapons
30 to an appropriate state or local law enforcement agency for use or sale by
31 the law enforcement agency; or,

32 (2) ~~if~~ If the weapons are not suitable for use or sale by law
33 enforcement agencies, ~~may~~ order the weapons destroyed.

34 (b)(1) The sale of weapons by a law enforcement agency under this
35 section shall be at a public auction or by competitive bid.
