21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
24 the Arkansas State University for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following
25 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
33 or its successor.

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15 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
17 REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES. Upon determination by the president or chancellor
18 of Arkansas State University an institution of higher education that a
19 reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or consolidation of
20 administrative functions within the university institution is necessary for
21 efficient and effective operations of the university institution, the
22 president or chancellor, with approval of the Arkansas State University Board
23 of Trustees institution's board of trustees, may have the authority to
24 transfer positions, appropriations and related funds between campuses,
25 divisions, branches, and other budgetary units of Arkansas State University
26 the institution, after receiving prior approval of the Legislative Council or
27 Joint Budget Committee. The transfers of positions, programs, or activities
28 shall be used for those purposes for which the appropriations were approved
29 by the General Assembly. The transfers, consolidations, or reorganizations
30 which involve academic programs shall be reviewed by the Department of Higher
31 Education and receive prior approval from the Legislative Council or the
32 Joint Budget Committee prior to submission to the Legislative Council or
33 Joint Budget Committee. Provided, however, that the institution shall be
34 limited to submitting no more than four (4) individual transaction transfer
35 requests during any fiscal year and shall be further limited to no more than
36 five percent (5%) of the total General Revenue and Special Revenue

1 appropriation, funding, positions specific to each institution and no Tobacco
2 Settlement funds or appropriations may be reallocated pursuant to this
3 section.

4 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
5 appropriation and general revenue funding for ~~a state agency~~ institutions of
6 higher education each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly.
7 This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the
8 appropriation act(s) for ~~a state agency~~ institutions of higher education and
9 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by

6 Technical Center. These positions are to be used by ASU Technical Center in

10 (b) ASU Technical Center shall provide justification to the Department of

13 assigned to the pool until such time as specific positions are requested and
14 justified by ASU Technical Center, recommended by OPM and approved by the
15 Legislative Council. ASU Technical Center may transfer positions from this
16 pool to any pay schedule the agency currently maintains or any pay schedule
17 the agency receives during the ~~2005-2007~~ 2007-2009 biennium.
18 (c) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is
19 the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by
20 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the
21 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has
22 determined that ASU Technical Center could be operated more efficiently if
23 some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is being
24 accomplished by providing growth pools in subsection (a) of this section and
25 since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers under the
26 growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General
27 Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the growth pool by
28 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the
29 growth pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative
30 Council is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of
31 approval by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court of
32 competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.
33 If the agency requests continuation of a "Growth Pool" position(s) as
34 established herein during the next biennium, the position(s) must be
35 requested as a new position(s) in the agencies biennial budget request.
36 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~ 2007

3 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

5 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged
6 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the
7 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief
8 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December
9 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or
10 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during
11 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.
12 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the
13 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon
14 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal
15 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board
16 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.

2 Arkansas State University shall report all such salary adjustments to the
3 State Office of Personnel Management (Higher Education Section) not later
4 than the pay period following such action and the Office of Personnel
5 Management shall in turn report such actions to the Uniform Personnel
6 Committee at the next scheduled meeting. Authority under this section shall
7 be subject to audit by both the Office of Personnel Management and the
8 Legislative Council and may be rescinded for improper use of application.

32 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
36 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

1 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
2 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
3 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
4 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
5 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
6 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
