22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23

24 *SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the*  
25 *Department of Arkansas State Police for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following*  
26 *maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the*  
27 *provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code*  
28 *§§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.*  
29 *Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual*  
30 *salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of*  
31 *said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying*  
32 *positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the*  
33 *Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),*  
34 *or its successor.*

4           Current employees whose salaries are awarded a one time adjustment and whose  
5           salaries exceed Pay Level IV, shall be eligible to receive such adjustment,  
6           not to exceed six percent, in a lump sum payment and such payment shall not  
7           be construed as exceeding the maximum salary for the grade.

8           As a pre-requisite to implementation of the rates of pay authorized in this  
9           section, the Arkansas State Police shall submit a salary structure and  
10           administration plan that addresses the recruiting and retention needs of the  
11           Department for approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and approval  
12           by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

13  
14           Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of  
15           appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year  
16           is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by  
17           delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and  
18           the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by  
19           amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly  
20           has determined that the Department of Arkansas State Police may operate more  
21           efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Arkansas  
22           State Police authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is  
23           both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight  
24           by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
25           Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the  
26           Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this

35           PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby  
36           authorized to purchase from Maintenance & General Operations Classifications

1 in the Operations Appropriation provided by this Act, up to an amount not to  
2 exceed \$2,500 each fiscal year, promotional items, authorized by the Director  
3 of the Department to meet requirements of the Arkansas State Police Strategic  
4 Recruitment Plan.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007  
6 through June 30, 2009.

7  
8 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COURT AWARDS FUND  
10 TRANSFER PROVISION. Monies deposited in the Court Awards Fund each fiscal  
11 year may be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or  
12 motor vehicle equipping and renovation costs, agency operational needs and  
13 capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police. Provided  
14 however, funds received from the Special State Assets Forfeiture Fund shall  
15 be deposited into the Court Awards Fund to be used by the Department of  
16 Arkansas State Police for law enforcement purposes consistent with governing  
17 federal law. The Department of Arkansas State Police may also request a fund  
18 transfer from the Court Awards Fund or the Arkansas State Police Fund to the  
19 Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund. The provisions of this section  
20 shall be subject to prior review and approval of the Arkansas Legislative  
21 Council or Joint Budget Committee.

8 the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to request transfer  
9 from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds Transfer" to the  
10 Maintenance and General Operations classifications established in the  
11 operations appropriation of the Department of Arkansas State Police, and may  
12 be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or motor vehicle  
13 equipping/renovation costs, agency operational needs and capital improvements  
14 for the Department of Arkansas State Police. Fund transfers may be requested  
15 from the Court Awards Fund to the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund in  
16 the same amount and for the same purposes as the appropriation transfer  
17 requested under the provisions of this section. The provisions of this  
18 section shall be subject to prior review and approval of the Arkansas  
19 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

5 ACQUISITION REVOLVING FUND – MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. At least  
6 fifty percent (50%) of the general revenues and/or general improvement funds  
7 deposited into the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be used for  
8 motor vehicle purchases and/or motor vehicle renovation costs for the  
9 Department of Arkansas State Police. The provisions of this section shall be  
10 in effect only from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009.

11  
12 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME.  
14 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime  
15 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to  
16 those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be  
17 assigned by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police to  
18 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable  
19 to Arkansas State Police by federal or local authorities as approved by the  
20 Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police. All such overtime  
21 payments shall be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be  
22 in addition to the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~  
24 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

26 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR  
28 VEHICLE PURCHASE. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby  
29 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for  
30 Capital Outlay in the State Police Operations appropriation in this Act.

31 Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police and confiscated vehicles  
32 used for Arkansas State Police operations shall not be included in the  
33 maximum number of authorized passenger vehicles.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~  
35 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

1 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORM  
3 EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas  
4 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer  
5 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
6 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee  
7 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the  
8 beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims  
9 paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined  
10 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance  
11 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the  
12 department, the ~~85th~~ 86th General Assembly shall study the feasibility and  
13 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide  
14 medical and hospital insurance to uniform employees through the public  
15 employees insurance program.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~  
17 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

18  
19 SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
20 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
21 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
22 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
23 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
24 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
25 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
26 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
27 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

28  
29 SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
30 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
31 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
32 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
33 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
34 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
35 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
36 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
