16 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS  
17 COMMUNITY COLLEGE AT HOPE APPROPRIATION  
18 FOR THE 2007-2009 BIENNIUM.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for  
25 the University of Arkansas Community College at Hope for the 2007-2009  
26 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries  
27 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and  
28 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and  
29 all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a  
30 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt  
31 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All  
32 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the  
33 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas  
34 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

24 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the  
 25 University of Arkansas Community College at Hope for the 2007-2009 biennium,  
 26 the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known  
 27 as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes:  
 28 *Two Hundred (200)* temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of  
 29 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
 30 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
 31 classification.

33 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 34 to the University of Arkansas Community College at Hope, to be payable from  
 35 the University of Arkansas Community College at Hope Fund, for personal  
 36 services and operating expenses of the University of Arkansas Community

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3 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - TREASURY CONTINGENCY. There is hereby  
4 appropriated, to the University of Arkansas Community College at Hope, to be  
5 payable from the University of Arkansas Community College at Hope Fund, for  
6 personal services and operating expenses which may be transferred and added  
7 to any appropriation line item payable from the University of Arkansas  
8 Community College at Hope Fund by the University of Arkansas Community  
9 College at Hope for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

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16 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
18 PRIORITIES. A high priority of the University of Arkansas Community College  
19 at Hope is to provide quality technical training programs, transfer programs,  
20 and workforce education.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~  
22 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

24 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
26 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged  
27 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the  
28 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief  
29 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December  
30 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or  
31 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during  
32 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.  
33 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the  
34 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon  
35 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal  
36 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board

1 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005  
3 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

4  
5 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
6 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
7 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
8 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
9 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
10 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
11 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
12 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
13 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
14 with in disbursement of said funds.

15  
16 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
17 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
18 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
19 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
20 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
22 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
23 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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25 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
26 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
27 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
28 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of  
29 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
30 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
31 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the  
32 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
33 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
34 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
35 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
