12 OBTAINING A FOUR-YEAR DEGREE IN EDUCATION IN  
13 ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 TO REQUEST THAT THE HOUSE INTERIM  
16 COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION AND THE SENATE  
17 INTERIM COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION STUDY THE  
18 REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING A FOUR- YEAR  
19 DEGREE IN EDUCATION IN ARKANSAS.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. (a) The purpose of this act is to request that the House  
26 Interim Committee on Education and the Senate Interim Committee on Education  
27 study the requirements for obtaining a four-year degree in education in  
28 Arkansas.

29 (b) The study shall look at degree programs at institutions of higher  
30 education in the state, the courses required for degree completion, the  
31 number of hours required for a secondary degree program, and the number of  
32 hours that are required to obtain an additional certificate to teach after  
33 the person has received his or her original certification.
