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27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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29 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - CHILD ABUSE/RAPE/DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CONTRACT.
30 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration
31 - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund
32 Account, for personal services reimbursement and expenses of the Child
33 Abuse/Rape/Domestic Violence Section of the University of Arkansas - Medical
34 Sciences by the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer
35 which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in

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9 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
10 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
11 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
12 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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19 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
20 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
26 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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28 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
29 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
30 the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer are, due to
31 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Finance and
32 Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue to provide essential
33 governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the
34 necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration -
35 Disbursing Officer to continue such services; and that a delay in the
36 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper

1 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
2 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
3 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
4 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

5 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
6 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
7 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
8 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
9 the veto.
