## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR COMPUTER AND  
10 ELECTRONIC RECYCLING FOR THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT  
11 OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY WHICH SHALL BE  
12 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS  
13 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 2022 OF 2005; AND FOR OTHER  
14 PURPOSES.

18 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF  
19 ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY - COMPUTER AND  
20 ELECTRONIC RECYCLING SUPPLEMENTAL  
21 APPROPRIATION.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
25

26 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - COMPUTER AND ELECTRONIC RECYCLING. There is  
27 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality, to  
28 be payable from the Computer and Electronic Recycling Fund, for grants and  
29 expenses of the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality - Computer and  
30 Electronic Recycling Fund which shall be supplemental and in addition to  
31 those funds appropriated in Section 31 of Act 2022 of 2005, the following:

1 MANAGEMENT EXPENSES OR GRANTS \$ 150,000

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3 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
4 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
5 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
6 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
10 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.  
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13 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
14 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
15 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
16 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
17 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
18 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
19 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
20 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
21

22 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
23 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of  
24 the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality are, due to unforeseen  
25 circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas Department of Environmental  
26 Quality to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the  
27 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas  
28 Department of Environmental Quality to continue such services; and that a  
29 delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the  
30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
34 passage and approval.

35 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
36 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor

1 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
2 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides  
3 the veto.
