19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-8-701(c), concerning the filing of the
22 statement of financial interest, is amended to read as follows:

23 (c)(1)(A) The statement of financial interest for the previous
24 calendar year shall be filed by January 31 of each year, except that a
25 candidate for elective office shall file the statement of financial interest
26 for the previous calendar year ~~within thirty (30) days after the deadline for~~
27 ~~filing for office for which he or she seeks election~~ on the first Monday
28 following the close of the period to file as a candidate for the elective
29 office, and persons identified in subdivisions (a)(4) and (a)(5) of this
30 section shall file the statement of financial interest within thirty (30)
31 days after appointment or employment.

32 (B) If a person is included in any category listed in
33 subsection (a) of this section for any part of a calendar year, then such
34 person shall file a statement of financial interest covering that period of
35 time regardless of whether the person has left his or her office or position



1 as of the date that statement of financial interest is due.

2 (2) Any incumbent officeholder who filed the statement of
3 financial interest by January 31 of the year in which the election is held
4 shall not be required to file an additional statement upon becoming a
5 candidate for reelection or election to another office at any election held
6 during the year.
