AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE PURPOSES OF THE
APPROPRIATION ENACTED BY ACT 1718 AND ACT 2315 OF
THE REGULAR SESSION OF 2005; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE PURPOSES OF ACT
1718 AND ACT 2315 OF THE REGULAR SESSION
OF 2005.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Uncodified Section 1 of Act 1718 of 2005 is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS – SALINE COUNTY CAREER CENTER. There is hereby appropriated, to the Pulaski Technical College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

(A) For construction, renovation, personal services, operating expenses, new programs and associated costs for the Saline County Career Center, the sum of\$600,000.

SECTION 2. The funds received by Pulaski Technical College as authorized by Act 2315 of the Regular Session of 2005 for the construction, renovation



1 and associated costs for the Saline County Career Center may also be used by
2 Pulaski Technical College for personal services, operating expenses and new
3 programs.

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5 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
6 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Act 1718 of 2005 enacted an
7 appropriation to assist Pulaski Technical College with Saline County Career
8 Center construction, renovation and associated costs; that Act 2315 of 2005
9 authorized funding to assist Pulaski Technical College with Saline County
10 Career Center costs; and that since the passage of these acts, it has become
11 apparent that these funds are needed for other critical costs at the Saline
12 County Career Center. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and
13 this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
14 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date
15 of its passage and approval.

16 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
17 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
18 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
19 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
20 the veto.
