18 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC
19 EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM SUPPLEMENTAL
20 APPROPRIATION.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT OPERATIONS. There is
26 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System, to
27 be payable from the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System Fund, for
28 extra help and operating expenses of the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement
29 System which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
30 appropriated in Section 3 of Act 1433 of 2005, the following:

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8 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
10 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
11 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
14 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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18 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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27 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
28 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
29 the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System are, due to unforeseen
30 circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement
31 System to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the
32 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas
33 Public Employees Retirement System to continue such services; and that a
34 delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the
35 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
36 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

1 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
2 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
3 passage and approval.

4 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
5 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
6 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
7 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
8 the veto.
