22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - BOILER INSPECTION. There is hereby
25 appropriated, to the Department of Labor, to be payable from the Department
26 of Labor Special Fund, for operating expenses of the Department of Labor -
27 Boiler Inspection which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
28 appropriated in Section 3 of Act 1420 of 2005, the following:

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5 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION – BOARD OF ELECTRICAL EXAMINERS. There is hereby
 6 appropriated, to the Department of Labor, to be payable from the Department
 7 of Labor Special Fund, for operating expenses of the Department of Labor –
 8 Board of Electrical Examiners which shall be supplemental and in addition to
 9 those funds appropriated in Section 4 of Act 1420 of 2005, the following:

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21 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 22 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 23 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 24 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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31 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 32 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 33 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 34 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 35 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 36 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
2 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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4 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
5 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
6 the Department of Labor are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient
7 for the Department of Labor to continue to provide essential governmental
8 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies
9 for the Department of Labor to continue such services; and that a delay in
10 the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
11 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
12 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
13 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
14 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

15 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
16 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
17 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
18 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
19 the veto.
