## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE  
11 UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR  
12 MATHEMATICS, SCIENCES AND ARTS WHICH SHALL BE  
13 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS  
14 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 2125 OF 2005; AND FOR OTHER  
15 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

18 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS -  
19 ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS,  
20 SCIENCES AND ARTS SUPPLEMENTAL  
21 APPROPRIATION.  
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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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27 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
28 to the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the School for Math,  
29 Science and Arts Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the  
30 University of Arkansas - Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences and Arts  
31 which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in  
32 Section 8 of Act 2125 of 2005, the following:

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13 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 14 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 15 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 16 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
 19 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
 20 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
 21 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
 22 with in disbursement of said funds.

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24 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 25 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 26 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 27 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 28 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 29 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 30 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 31 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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33 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 34 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of  
 35 the University of Arkansas are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient  
 36 for the University of Arkansas to continue to provide essential governmental

1 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies  
2 for the University of Arkansas to continue such services; and that a delay in  
3 the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper  
4 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,  
5 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the  
6 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in  
7 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

8 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
9 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
10 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
11 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides  
12 the veto.
