AN ACT TO AMEND § 26-3-306(a)(1)(B)(iii) TO REINSTATE THE HOMESTEAD AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS AVAILABLE TO A DISABLED VETERAN'S SURVIVING SPOUSE WHOSE SUBSEQUENT MARRIAGE HAS TERMINATED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND § 26-3-306(a)(1)(B)(iii) TO REINSTATE THE HOMESTEAD AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS AVAILABLE TO A DISABLED VETERAN'S SURVIVING SPOUSE WHOSE SUBSEQUENT MARRIAGE HAS TERMINATED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-3-306(a)(1)(B)(iii), concerning the homestead and personal property exemptions of a surviving spouse, is amended to read as follows:
(iii)(a) The surviving spouse shall be entitled to the exemption provided for in this section so long as the surviving spouse remains unmarried.
(b) The surviving spouse's exemptions provided
for in this section are reinstated upon the termination of the surviving spouse's subsequent marriage.
