## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION REAPPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - BLACK RIVER TECHNICAL COLLEGE - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Black River Technical College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Black River Technical College, the following:

 13 General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the projects provided or  
 14 enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will expire before the  
 15 adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such appropriations expire,  
 16 the projects and programs authorized herein will cease thereby depriving the  
 17 citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from such projects.  
 18 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
 19 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
 20 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2006.
