10	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the			
11	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that economic development,

14	pursuant to which the State Highway Commission can approve the transfer, by			
15	gift or contract, to a regional intermodal facilities authority, a			
16	metropolitan port authority, or a planning and development district, or			
17	surplus rail and other track material purchased by the Arkansas State Parks,			
18	Recreation, and Travel Commission or the Department of Parks and Tourism or
