SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 9-10-115(f), concerning child support obligations, is amended to read as follows:
(f)(l) If the test administered under subdivision (e)(l)(A) of this section excludes the adjudicated father or man deemed to be the father pursuant to an acknowledgment of paternity as the biological father of the child and the court so finds, the court shall:
(A) setSet aside the previous finding or establishment of paternity and;
(B) Find that there is no future obligation of support;
(C) Order that any unpaid support owed under the previous
order is vacated; and
(D) Order that any support previously paid is not subject

## to refund

(2) If the name of the adjudicated father or man deemed to be the father pursuant to an acknowledgment of paternity appears on the birth
certificate of the child, the court shall issue an order requiring the birth certificate to be amended to delete the name of the father.
