8	application to their fund's board of trustees, and also be eligible for
9	benefit increases granted during the interim between their benefit
10	termination and restoration, subject to the board of trustees' discretion;
11	and that this act is immediately necessary for the protection of these
12	surviving spouses of firefighters. Therefore, an emergency is declared to
13	exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
14	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
15	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
16	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
17	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
18	<pre>bill; or</pre>
19	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
20	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
