10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES, GRANTS OR LOANS,
11 AND COMMUNITY GRANTS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND
12 OPERATION OF CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT PREVENTION
13 PROGRAMS FOR THE STATE CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT
14 PREVENTION BOARD FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING
15 JUNE 30, 2009; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

18 AN ACT FOR THE STATE CHILD ABUSE AND
19 NEGLECT PREVENTION BOARD APPROPRIATION
20 FOR THE 2007-2009 BIENNIUM.
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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION OPERATIONS. There is
27 hereby established for the State Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board -
28 Operations for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of
29 regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
30 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
31 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
32 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
33 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
34 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
35 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular



1 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
2 successor.

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11 SECTION 2. REGULAR SALARIES - COMMUNITY GRANTS. There is hereby
 12 established for the State Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board -
 13 Community Grants for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of
 14 regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
 15 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
 16 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,

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31 SECTION 3. EXTRA HELP - CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION - CHILDREN'S TRUST FUND.
 32 There is hereby authorized, for the State Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention
 33 Board for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time
 34 or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
 35 appropriated herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time
 36 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the

1 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act
 2 for the appropriate classification.

 4 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION OPERATIONS. There is
 5 hereby appropriated, to the State Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board,
 6 to be payable from the Children's Trust Fund, for personal services and
 7 operating expenses, and grants or loans for the development or operation of
 8 child abuse prevention programs of the State Child Abuse and Neglect
 9 Prevention Board – Operations for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009,

 27 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - COMMUNITY GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated,
 28 to the State Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board, to be payable from the
 29 federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for
 30 personal services and operating expenses, and community grants for the
 31 development or operation of child abuse prevention programs of the State
 32 Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board – Community Grants for the biennial
 33 period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

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12 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - ONE PERCENT TO PREVENT GRANTS. There is hereby
 13 appropriated, to the State Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board, to be
 14 payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for One Percent to
 15 Prevent child abuse prevention program grants for the development of services
 16 to children of incarcerated parents, caregivers of those children, and
 17 incarcerated parents by the State Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board -
 18 One Percent to Prevent Grants for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009,
 19 the following:

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25 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 26 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 28 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 31 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 36 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

1 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
2 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
3 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
5 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
6 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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8 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
9 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
10 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
11 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
12 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
13 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
14 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
15 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
16 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
17 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
18 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
