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           SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
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     General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that this act concerns the
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     disclosure of certain information in corporate franchise tax reports; that
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     the release of this information to the public at large is harmful to the
     report's filer; and that this act should become effective as soon as possible
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     to prevent this harm. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this
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     act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and
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     safety shall become effective on:
