4	SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS			
5	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.			
6	SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN PROGRAM - TRANSFER. In the event there is not			
7	sufficient appropriation and/or funding provided for by the General Assembly			
8	for any state agency, board or commission to participate in the Sustainable			
9	Building Design Program for renovations of state owned property which exceeds			
10	two hundred fifty thousand dollars ($\$250,000$), the agency may request a			
11	transfer from the Sustainable Building Design Program appropriation			
12	authorized in Section 3 of this Act from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the			
13	State. The request shall clearly state the amount required and such other			
14	information as may be required by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State			
15	necessary to make a decision regarding the request. Upon approval of the			
16	Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review by the Arkansas			
17	Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the State Auditor shall be

28	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS			
29	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.			
30	SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN PROGRAM - REVOLVING LOAN FUND. The Sustainable			
31	Building Design Program Appropriation is intended to provide additional			
32	appropriation authority for the Sustainable Building Design Program. Funding			
33	for the program may be made available by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the			
34	State, in the form of a loan, from a transfer from the Sustainable Building			
35	Design Revolving Loan Fund after the required review by the Arkansas			
36	Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, approval by the Chief Fiscal			

- 1 Officer of the State and approval through rules and regulations established
- 2 and administered by the Arkansas Building Authority. Moneys made available
- 3 for the repayment of a loan shall be deposited to the credit of the

- 13 SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS. Rules and
- 14 Regulations shall be established and administered by the Arkansas Building
- 15 Authority for the Sustainable Building Design Program prior to the
- 16 implementation of any transfers of appropriation and/or funding. The Rules
- 17 and Regulations shall be reviewed by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget

- 20 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
- 22 TRANSFER. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may transfer from time to
- 23 time on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of
- 24 the State funding which is made available from General Improvement Funds
- 25 allocated and distributed to the Arkansas Building Authority in an amount not
- 26 to exceed three million dollars (\$3,000,000) from the General Improvement
- 27 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts to the Sustainable Building
- 28 Design Revolving Loan Fund to provide funds for the appropriation provided
- 29 herein or for appropriation authority as may be provided by law to provide
- 30 loans to agencies for the Sustainable Building Design Program.

- 32 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
- 34 TRANSFER. From time to time, the Chief Fiscal Office of the State may
- 35 transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor
- 36 of the State the sum not to exceed twelve million dollars (\$12,000,000) from

1	Federal Funds as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to the		
2	Sustainable Building Design Revolving Loan Fund to provide funds for the		
3	appropriations herein.		
4			
5	SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized		
6	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds		
7	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the		
8	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and		
9	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary		
10	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal		
11	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by		
12	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be		
13	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.		
14			
15	SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly		
16	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained		
17	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act		
18	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations		
19	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by		
20	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral		
21	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or		
22	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.		
23			
24	SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
25	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
26	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
27	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of		
28	the agency for which the appropriations in this \mbox{Act} are provided, and that \mbox{in}		
29	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the		
30	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm		
31	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental		
32	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act		
33	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health		
34	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
