AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
HUMAN SERVICES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
SERVICES REAPPROPRIATION.

18
19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - GENERAL
22 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human
23 Services, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
24 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Human Services, the following:

25 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
26 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1037 of 2009, for grants for repairs,
27 technology, training, infrastructure needs and expenses for county hospitals,
28 in a sum not to exceed \$40,000.
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30 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
31 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1156 of 2009, for a grant to an organization for
32 training, job readiness, and adult literacy services of former prisoners to
33 be re-introduced into society, in a sum not to exceed \$15,000.
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35 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
36 Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 1156 of 2009, for a grant to an organization for

1 youth summer employment programs for tutoring, mentoring, educational,
2 social, recreational, personal services and operating expenses, in a sum not
3 to exceed\$15,000.

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5 (D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
6 Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 1156 of 2009, for a grant to a domestic violence
7 shelter for crisis intervention, safe shelter, support services, personal
8 services and operating expenses, and social and legal advocacy services, in a
9 sum not to exceed\$20,000.

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11 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES - GENERAL
12 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human
13 Services - Division of Administrative Services, to be payable from the
14 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
15 Department of Human Services - Division of Administrative Services, the
16 following:

17 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
18 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 138 of 2009, for various maintenance,
19 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and
20 repair projects for all state-owned real property and facilities department-
21 wide, in a sum not to exceed\$4,007,272.

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23 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
24 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 506 of 2009, for maintenance, renovation,
25 equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair
26 projects for all state-owned real property and facilities department-wide, in
27 a sum not to exceed\$10,000,000.

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29 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
30 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1075 of 2009, for grants and assistance to
31 community organizations for maintenance and general operations, personal
32 services, and construction expenses, in a sum not to exceed\$500,000.

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34 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF AGING AND ADULT SERVICES -
35 GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human
36 Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services, to be payable from the

1 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
2 Department of Human Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services, the
3 following:

4 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
5 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1027 of 2009, for grants for construction,
6 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
7 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
8\$200,000.

9
10 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
11 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1033 of 2009, for grants for construction,
12 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
13 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
14\$80,000.

15
16 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
17 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1062 of 2009, for a grant for hospice providers
18 for construction, renovation, personal services, operating, purchase of
19 equipment, and major maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed
20\$250,000.

21
22 (D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
23 Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 1062 of 2009, for grants for construction,
24 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
25 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
26\$250,000.

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28 (E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
29 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1069 of 2009, for grants for construction,
30 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
31 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
32\$50,000.

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34 (F) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
35 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1088 of 2009, for grants for personal services
36 and operating expenses, construction, renovation, and the purchase of

1 equipment to older Arkansan services providers to provide various community-
 2 based senior services, including but not limited to, congregate and home-
 3 delivered meals, client representation, information and assistance,
 4 socialization, adult day care and transportation, in a sum not to exceed
 5\$160,000.

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 7 (G) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
 8 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1107 of 2009, for grants for construction,
 9 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
 10 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
 11\$200,000.

12
 13 (H) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
 14 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1150 of 2009, for a pilot program for the
 15 Arkansas Area Agency on Aging to serve week-end frozen home delivered meals
 16 to eligible recipients in Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$120,000.

17
 18 (I) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
 19 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1245 of 2009, for grants to Area Agencies on
 20 Aging for construction, renovation, personal services and operating expenses,
 21 purchase of equipment, and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a
 22 sum not to exceed\$200,000.

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 24 (J) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
 25 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1248 of 2009, for grants for construction,
 26 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
 27 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
 28\$200,000.

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 30 (K) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
 31 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1255 of 2009, for grants for construction,
 32 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
 33 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
 34\$250,000.

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 36 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH - DRUG ABUSE

2 Department of Human Services - Division of Behavioral Health, to be payable
3 from the Drug Abuse Prevention and Treatment Fund, for the Department of
4 Human Services - Division of Behavioral Health, the following:

5 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
6 Section 2 of Act 851 of 2009, for behavioral health services to the citizens
7 of the State of Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$300,000.

9 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
10 Section 2 of Act 907 of 2009, for behavioral health services to the citizens
11 of the State of Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$300,000.

12

13 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
14 Section 2 of Act 1003 of 2009, for behavioral health services to the citizens
15 of the State of Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$200,000.

16

17 (D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
18 Section 2 of Act 1004 of 2009, for behavioral health services to the citizens
19 of the State of Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$300,000.

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21 (E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
22 Section 2 of Act 1070 of 2009, for behavioral health services to the citizens
23 of the State of Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$200,000.

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25 (F) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
26 Section 2 of Act 1074 of 2009, for behavioral health services to the citizens
27 of the State of Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$50,000.

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29 (G) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

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33 (H) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

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1 (I) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
2 Section 2 of Act 1390 of 2009, for behavioral health services and community
3 based services to the citizens of the State of Arkansas, in a sum not to
4 exceed\$200,000.

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6 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH - PAYING
7 ACCOUNT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services -
8 Division of Behavioral Health, to be payable from the paying account as
9 determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of
10 Human Services - Division of Behavioral Health, the following:

11 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
12 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for the replacement of the roof on
13 the Court House Building at the Arkansas State Hospital, in a sum not to
14 exceed\$58,900.

15
16 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
17 Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for the replacement of the roof on
18 the Material Management Building at the Arkansas State Hospital, in a sum not
19 to exceed\$83,700.

20
21 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
22 Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for heating, ventilating, and air
23 conditioning (HVAC) systems for Units 5 and 6 at the Arkansas State Hospital,
24 in a sum not to exceed\$294,500.

25
26 (D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
27 Item (D) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for tuck point and seal
28 improvements to Buildings 5 and 6 at the Arkansas State Hospital, in a sum
29 not to exceed\$62,000.

30
31 (E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
32 Item (E) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for the replacement of the gym
33 floor at the Arkansas State Hospital, in a sum not to exceed\$7,750.

34
35 (F) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
36 Item (F) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for a new electronic boiler monitor

1 for Rogers Hall and Fullerton at the Arkansas State Hospital, in a sum not to
2 exceed\$46,500.

3
4 (G) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
5 Item (G) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for the replacement of the existing
6 fire alarm system in the Forensic Building at the Arkansas State Hospital, in
7 a sum not to exceed\$29,450.

8
9 (H) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
10 Item (H) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for a forensic camera system at the
11 Arkansas State Hospital, in a sum not to exceed\$60,450.

12
13 (I) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
14 Item (I) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for asphalt construction and
15 improvements to the Lower South Parking Lot and Drive at the Arkansas State
16 Hospital, in a sum not to exceed\$63,550.

17
18 (J) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
19 Item (J) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for the replacement of the roof on
20 the Maintenance Building at the Arkansas State Hospital, in a sum not to
21 exceed\$62,000.

22
23 (K) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
24 Item (K) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for the replacement of the existing
25 intercom system in the Forensic Building at the Arkansas State Hospital, in a
26 sum not to exceed\$31,000.

27
28 (L) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
29 Item (L) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for the installation of a covered
30 canopy from Cross Hall to the Gymnasium at the Arkansas State Hospital, in a
31 sum not to exceed\$31,000.

32
33 (M) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
34 Item (M) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for the installation of a sprinkler
35 system in the Forensic Building at the Arkansas State Hospital, in a sum not
36 to exceed\$124,000.

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(N) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (N) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for the replacement of the Forensic Unit storm sewer lines at the Arkansas State Hospital, in a sum not to exceed\$62,000.

(O) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (O) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for the purchase, maintenance, improvement, or repair of equipment for the Ford Fusion 911 Program at the Arkansas State Hospital, in a sum not to exceed\$4,960.

(P) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (P) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for the purchase, maintenance, improvement or repair of a cargo van for the Arkansas State Hospital, in a sum not to exceed\$6,975.

(Q) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (Q) of Section 1 of Act 507 of 2009, for the purchase, maintenance, improvement or repair of a commercial riding mower for the Arkansas State Hospital, in a sum not to exceed\$3,100.

(B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 860 of 2009, for a grant for Community Mental Health Centers for uncompensated care, in a sum not to exceed ..\$4,000,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

1 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 875 of 2009, for an alcohol and drug abuse
2 treatment program capital improvement grant for personal services and
3 operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation and
4 maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed\$500,000.

28 operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
29 maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed\$250,000.

31 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
32 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1068 of 2009, for grants to community programs
33 serving developmentally disabled individuals for personal services and
34 operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
35 maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed\$100,000.

1 SECTION 9. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF VOLUNTEERISM - GENERAL

 11 improve efficiency, and a network for professional and organizational
 12 engagement, in a sum not to exceed\$50,000.

14 SECTION 10. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES - YOUTH SERVICES
 15 FACILITIES NEEDS FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of

15 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BED
17 EXPANSION. As referenced in Section 1 of Act 506 of 2009, the authorized
18 funding and appropriation for the Department of Human Services - Division of
19 Administrative Services for maintenance, renovation, equipping, construction,
20 acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair projects for all state-owned
21 real property and facilities department-wide, shall also be deemed to include
22 the expansion of available statewide mental health beds to serve individuals
23 with mental illness in Arkansas.

24
25 SECTION 14. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
26 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
27 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
28 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
29 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
30 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
31 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
32 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
33 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
34 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
35 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
36 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

1 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
2 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
3 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
4 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
5 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
6 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

7
8 *SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.* It is the intent of the General Assembly
9 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
10 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
11 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
12 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
13 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
14 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
15 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

16
17 *SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General*
18 *Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the*
19 *appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the*
20 *effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010, with the exception that Sections*
21 *12 and 13 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the*
22 *date of its passage and approval, is essential to the operation of the agency*
23 *for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event*
24 *of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date*
25 *of this Act beyond July 1, 2010, with the exception that Sections 12 and 13*
26 *in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its*
27 *passage and approval, could work irreparable harm upon the proper*
28 *administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,*
29 *an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the*
30 *immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in*
31 *full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010, with the exception that*
32 *Sections 12 and 13 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and*
33 *after the date of its passage and approval.*
