9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATING
10 EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF
11 ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL
12 AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY
13 ACT 1281 OF 2007; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF
17 ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY SUPPLEMENTAL
18 APPROPRIATION.
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - FEE ADMINISTRATION. There is hereby
25 appropriated, to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality, to be
26 payable from the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund,
27 for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Department of
28 Environmental Quality which shall be supplemental and in addition to those
29 funds appropriated in Section 13 of Act 1281 of 2007, the following:

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6 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
7 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
8 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
9 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
12 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
13 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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16 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
17 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
18 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
19 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
20 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
22 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
23 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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25 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
26 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
27 the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality are, due to unforeseen
28 circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas Department of Environmental
29 Quality to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the
30 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas
31 Department of Environmental Quality to continue such services; and that a
32 delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the
33 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
34 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
35 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
36 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its

1 passage and approval.

2 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
3 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
4 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
5 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
6 the veto.
