26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-10-205(a)(3), concerning the powers and
29 duties of the Arkansas Energy Office, is amended to read as follows:

30 (3) Collecting data on, planning, and administering emergency
31 plans, when needed, to allocate the distribution of motor fuels, aviation
32 fuels, heating oil, and propane by wholesale jobbers and dealers within the
33 state;

35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 15-10-205(b)(3), concerning the authority



1 of the Arkansas Energy Office, is amended to read as follows:

2 (3) Promulgate reasonable rules and regulations for the purpose
3 of:

4 (A) Implementing ~~implementing~~ and prescribing enforcement
5 for thermal and lighting efficiency standards for new building construction;
6 and

7 (B) Requiring a city or county that issues building
8 permits for new building construction to adopt the 2004 Arkansas Energy Code
9 for New Building Construction, as it existed on January 1, 2009;
