19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-27-1502 is amended to read as follows:

22 20-27-1502. Unlawful to perform body art on a person under eighteen
23 (18) years of age.

24 (a) A person under eighteen (18) years of age shall not undergo body
25 art unless:

26 (1) Written consent is given by the person's parent or legal
27 guardian; and

28 (2)(A) The parent or legal guardian is present during the
29 procedure.

30 (B) When providing written consent, the parent or legal
31 guardian shall produce photo-bearing identification and attest in writing
32 that the individual is the person's parent or legal guardian.

33 (b) Regardless of age, the person receiving the body art shall attest
34 to the fact that he or she is not under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

35 (c) Printed instructions on the care of the skin and the body art



1 shall be given to each person after the procedure, and a copy of the
2 instructions shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the body art
3 establishment.

4 (d)(1) In addition to the attestations required in subsections (a) and
5 (b) of this section, records shall be kept of the names of all persons
6 receiving body art and of the parents or guardians giving consent ~~pursuant to~~
7 under the rules promulgated by the State Board of Health to implement this
8 subchapter.

9 (2) All required signatures shall be in ink, and required
10 records shall be available at a reasonable time for examination by the
11 ~~Department of Health and Human Services~~ the Department of Health and by local
12 health officials.

13 (e)(1) Except as provided in subsection (a) of this section, it is
14 unlawful to perform body art on a person under eighteen (18) years of age,
15 and any person ~~violating this prohibition shall be~~ who pleads guilty or nolo
16 contendere to or is found guilty of a violation of this subdivision is guilty
17 of a Class C misdemeanor.

18 (2) Any person who falsely claims to be the minor's parent or
19 legal guardian for the purpose of obtaining body art for a person under
20 eighteen (18) years of age shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.

21 (3) It is not a defense to a criminal prosecution under this
22 section that at the time of the offense, the person who received the body art
23 possessed a letter of consent from the person's parent or legal guardian if
24 the letter was forged or if a person falsely assumed the identity of the
25 minor's parent or legal guardian.

26 (f)(1) It is unlawful to perform body art on any person under eighteen
27 (18) years of age in any unlicensed facility.

28 (2) A person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to or is found
29 guilty of a violation of subdivision (f)(1) of this section is guilty of a
30 Class D felony.
